Week	Task	Date Completed
1	Assess what you already have! Make a Family Plan & make plans with an out-of-area contact.	
2	Collect Water & Food Purchase hand operated can opener Locate & Check Gas & Water valves Assess each room in home for potential hazards.	
3	Obtain initial storage container <i>Clothes</i> <i>Flashlight/extra batteries & bulb</i> Video contents of home & store with friend/family out of the area Copies of important papers, etc. and store out of your home.	
4	Check contents of SNAP Pack Obtain following: <i>Head Lamp</i> <i>Duct Tape</i> <i>Extra Batteries</i> <i>Bunge Cords (various lengths)</i> <i>Medium to large Crescent Wrench</i> <i>Pocket Knife</i> Install or test Smoke Detectors	
5	Obtain following: <i>Rope</i> <i>Emergency Blankets</i> <i>Wooden matches dipped in wax</i> <i>Small gas stove with extra gas</i> <i>Phillips & Regular Screwdrivers</i> <i>"Wonder" Pry Bar</i>	
6	Obtain First Aid supplies Know your child's disaster plan at school	
7	Know your disaster plan at work. Be prepared for disaster in middle of night. Obtain following: <i>Blankets or sleeping bags</i> <i>Portable communication devices - AM/FM Radio & Walkie Talkies</i>	
8	Immediately after SNAP Graduation, assess your own strengths and weaknesses! Create Car Pack Develop Neighborhood Plan Make sure neighbors are aware of SNAP!
